**CASE STUDY #10** PaSea H.EL.M.E.T. Marine Risk Assessment

**RISK ELEMENT:** Cargo & Bunker Sample Management

**MRA FINDING:** Cargo and bunker samples were stored in open shelves in the paint store instead of a lockable cabinet. Moreover, the shelves were made out of wood.

Despite the fact that the paint store was protected with a fixed fire-fighting system, the danger of fire was present due to the improper storage of the cargo & bunker samples, which were not securely stowed and the shelves were made of flammable material.

**IT IS SUGGESTED THAT THE STORAGE AND LOCATION OF CARGO & BUNKER SAMPLES IS CHECKED IN ORDER TO ENSURE THAT SAMPLES ARE SECURELY STOWED IN APPROVED TYPE LOCKERS**
